## Mail Order Service

We now despatch container-grown plants throughout the year. Bare rooted specimens, where available, will be despatched between October and March when the plants are dormant. Plants are sent out by carrier on a next day service so if there will be no-one available to accept the delivery, please send instructions with your order detailing where plants can be safely left. Plants will be despatched on receipt of payment unless a prior agreement has been made.

The nursery exports throughout the world. This is subject to the health regulations of the country in question and an import license may be required. In this case we have to acquire a Phytosanitary Certificate for which we are charged: this cost is payable by the customer. This does not apply to EEC countries where plant passports will be applied for where necessary.
