Jadi continues to be full of enthusiasm and introduces many new and interesting plants, some rare. We continue to increase our collections.

We specialise in growing trees and shrubs from seed, cuttings and grafts.

Unfortunately, it is getting more difficult to get seed from native stands due to plant health regulations. We try to get the nomenclature correct but we receive seed which sometimes is wrongly named and sometimes has no name at all so please bear with us: we do try our best to get it right!

We only have a small stock of the rarer plants, and these will be offered on a first come, first served basis.

NEW - This autumn we have a substantial quantity of large trees at 2.5 to 4m in height. These are marked **[L]** in the Catalogue.

Mail Order Service

We dispatch container-grown plants throughout the year. Bare root trees and shrubs are sent throughout the dormant season, October to March. All orders are sent out with APC on a 'next day' service. APC require all consignments to be boxed and will not take items which are over 2.2m in length. Plants over that size must be collected or delivered by our van.

Plants will be dispatched on receipt of payment unless a prior arrangement has been made.

Sadly, it is getting very difficult to send plants to Europe; for example, the EU have banned the import of *Quercus* species. Please do not hesitate to contact us for advice or with any questions - we will do our best!
