This year we have many new exciting offerings: we have a new collection of Quercus containing many from Mexico, some of which are very rare. We have several new Tilia and a good collection of Magnolia grown from seed.

Mail Order Service

We dispatch container-grown plants throughout the year. Bare root trees and shrubs are sent throughout the dormant season, October to March. All orders are sent out with APC on a 'next day' service. APC require all consignments to be boxed and will not take items which are over 2.2m in length. Plants over that size must be collected or delivered by our van.

Plants will be dispatched on receipt of payment unless a prior arrangement has been made.

Unfortunately, we are unable to send plants to Europe as a result of Brexit. Europe will not allow them to be imported.
